

Creating Penny Spinners For Elementary Students

This week's project is simple! All you'll need is a piece of cardboard, something to color with, scissors and a penny!

***Tip! Cardboard from an old cereal box works perfectly for this project!**



Step 1: With the help of a grown up, cut out a circle from your cardboard. Then, make a penny sized cut in the center. The cut for the penny should just be a small line, not a big hole!


Step 2: Use markers, crayons or colored pencils to create a fun design on the circle you cut out!


Step 3: Take a penny and put it into the hole you created. It should fit nice and tight so it doesn't fall out! Now, you should be able to stand your spinner up on the edge of the penny, and spin it like a top!
